

# STAYING SAFE AT THORNHAM WALKS

We want you to enjoy your visit to Thornham Walks, and to do so safely and in consideration of others. Please follow the simple guidelines below to restrict the spread of Coronavirus (Covid-19):

- 1) Thornham Walks is open daily between 9am and 6pm.
- 2) Visitors enter the site at their own risk. Please consider the number of visitors already on site and if it is safe to enter.
- 3) Please park sensibly, allowing suitable distance between cars.
- 4) Maintain social distancing. Please stay 2 metres (6 feet) apart from unrelated groups.
- 5) We operate Pay and Display car parks. Income from the car parks is invested in the management and operation of Thornham Walks and we would not be able to open without it. Please use the hand sanitiser located next to the machines after use.
- 6) The following are currently closed:
  - Volunteer and Visitor Centre
  - Bird Hide
- 7) Please keep dogs on leads at all times.
- 8) Cycling is not permitted on the footpaths.
- 9) Strictly no fires or barbeques are permitted on site. Visitors may use the designated grassed area by the main car park for picnics.
- 10) Please do not litter. Rubbish should be taken home, or put in the bins in the car parks.
